



SETTING UP YOUR STOVE

To avoid damage in transit, we have packed the glass window separately.

Unwrap the glass window and locate the bolts, nuts, and rectangular washers provided.

Position the glass onto the rear of the door and:

- 1) Insert bolts front to back
- 2) Thread through a washer
- 3) Lock in to place by screwing on a nut



NOSTALGIC VIBES and & TOASTY NIGHTS FROM THE COMFORT OF YOUR TENT

If your tent is from our Polycotton or Cotton canvas range, you can safely install your stove to amplify your home-away-from-home interior and keep it toasty!

Fire retardant tents are available and recommended. Scan the QR code below to see how you can install a flashing kit.



*A carbon monoxide alarm inside the tent is recommended.



- When in use, avoid touching the stove and flue without gloves on.
- Open the firebox door to create air flow, allowing the fire to breathe.
- Always work in well ventilated spaces with a constant supply of fresh air.
- Do not leave anything combustible near the stove. If installed in a tent, we recommend that sides and top are at least 60cm away from the fabric.
- We recommend using a carbon monoxide alarm when in use, especially in a tent.

- Protect your groundsheet /grass/flooring with a flame retardant heat mat (just in case hot embers escape).
- For extra stability on windy days, we recommend attaching two ropes to the holes in the spark arrestor and pegging firmly into the ground.
- To slow the fire, close the valve located above the window. Opening this will increase airflow and boost the fire, keeping it lit for longer.
- As the fire box is quite small in width we recommend using kindling or small logs along with fire starters
- If you are using the stove with a flashing kit, to minimise risks of the flue overheating, monitor the temperature to ensure it does not exceed 200°c.
